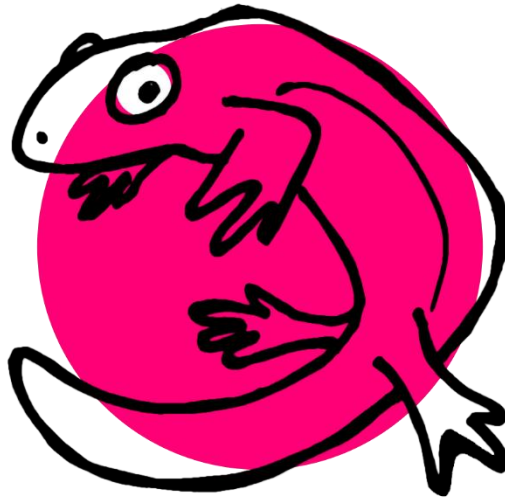

Cookies

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. The table below explains the cookies we use and why.

How we use cookies?

We currently only use cookies for functional and security reasons in order to improve your user experience.

Specifically:

- User authentication
- Anti forgery tokens (to prevent certain types of malicious attacks)

Note: These cookies are required for the website/system to work as intended. Disabling these cookies would cause the website/system to stop working as designed and will negatively affect your user experience.

How we don't use cookies.

We don't currently use cookies to track traffic to the site, track individual users or for analytical/reporting purposes.

How do I change my cookie settings?

Since we only use cookies to deliver required functionality, we don't offer the ability to disable them. You can disable cookies in your web browser.
